Life Membership

Nomination Guidelines

The following criteria are a guide for qualification for TUHC Life Membership. Determination as to the awarding of Life Membership is the responsibility of the elected Board.

It is anticipated that the recipient will have contributed to the club in the following areas. Category A contributions are considered as prime contributions. All contributions made by the individual should be of undoubted and significant benefit to the club.

Category A

- To have played A pool, B pool or underage for the TUHC over a sustained period (10+ years)
- To have coached A pool, B pool or underage over a sustained period (5+ years)
- Key Committee/Board portfolio holder over a sustained period (5+ years)

Category B

- A significant contribution to the TUHC over a sustained period
- Held other position(s) of note, such as that of a Committee or Board member, over a sustained period (5+ years)
- Team Captain over a sustained period (5+ years)
- Team Manager over a sustained period (5+ years)
- Club umpire over a sustained period (3+ years) or has made a significant contribution to umpire development
- To have coached a team to a premiership on more than 2 occasions

Minimum qualifications to be consider for Life Membership:

TWO Category A achievements and ONE Category B achievement

or

ONE Category A achievement and THREE Category B achievements

(If a candidate has contributed for five years in three lesser administrative or coaching roles, this will be sufficient grounds for one sustained achievement)

ASSESSMENT

- The aforementioned criteria are not automatic grounds for the granting of Life Membership
- In determining Life Membership, consideration will be given to a comparison of the achievements of existing life members.
- Life membership is awarded at the discretion of the TUHC Board.
